Q3] Evaluate the Role of ADR in Improving Access To Justice in Rural India.

Access to justice in rural India, where 65% of population resides, but hindered by poverty, illiteracy and judicial blockage, which results in 4 crore pending cases since 2023, here ADR mechanisms like mediation and Lok Adalats emerged as vital tools to bridge this gap.



Role of ADR in Improving Access

- (a) ADR, especially Lok Adalats is cost-effective with no court fees, making it accessible for rural poor communities.
 Eg: 1.5 crore cases settled in 2023.
- (b) Speedy Resolution in single sitting of disputes

in National Lok Adalats, less pressure on courts
 Eg: 6 lakh cases settled in one day, since 2023.

(c) ADR avoids complex legal processes, enabling illiterate rural litigants to participate without advocates.



Measures to Strengthen ADR in Rural India

- Awareness Campaigns: NALSA's door-to-door campaigns, in UP 2024 can boost awareness.
- Capacity Building via Training 1 lakh mediators by 2026, as planned by ministry of Law.
- Technology integration like E-Lok Adalats, piloted in 2020 can enhance virtual hearings.
- Dedicated women's Lok Adalats in Tamil Nadu.
- Amending Legal Services Authorities Act 1987, to make ADR outcomes enforceable can boost credibility.
